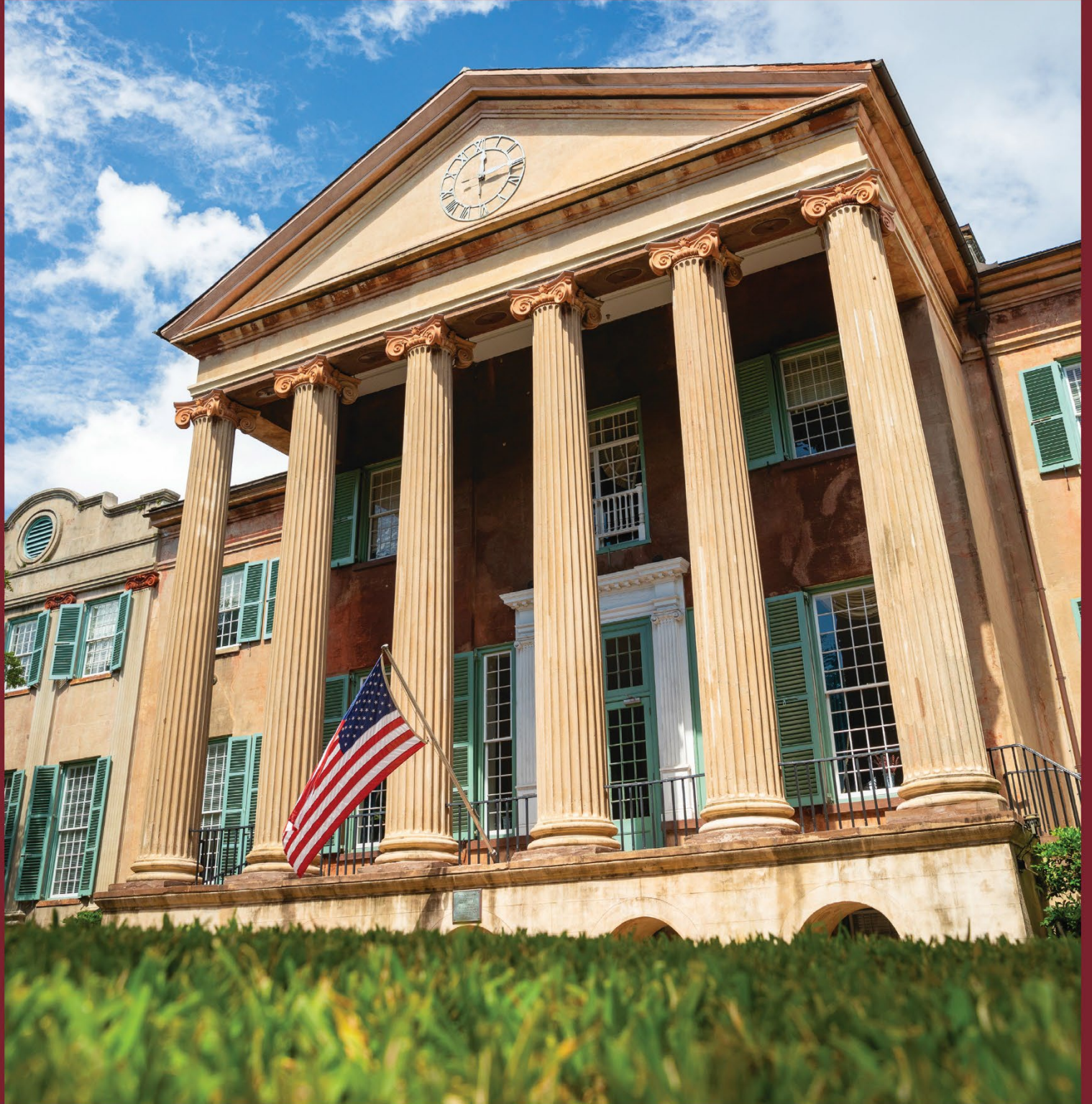

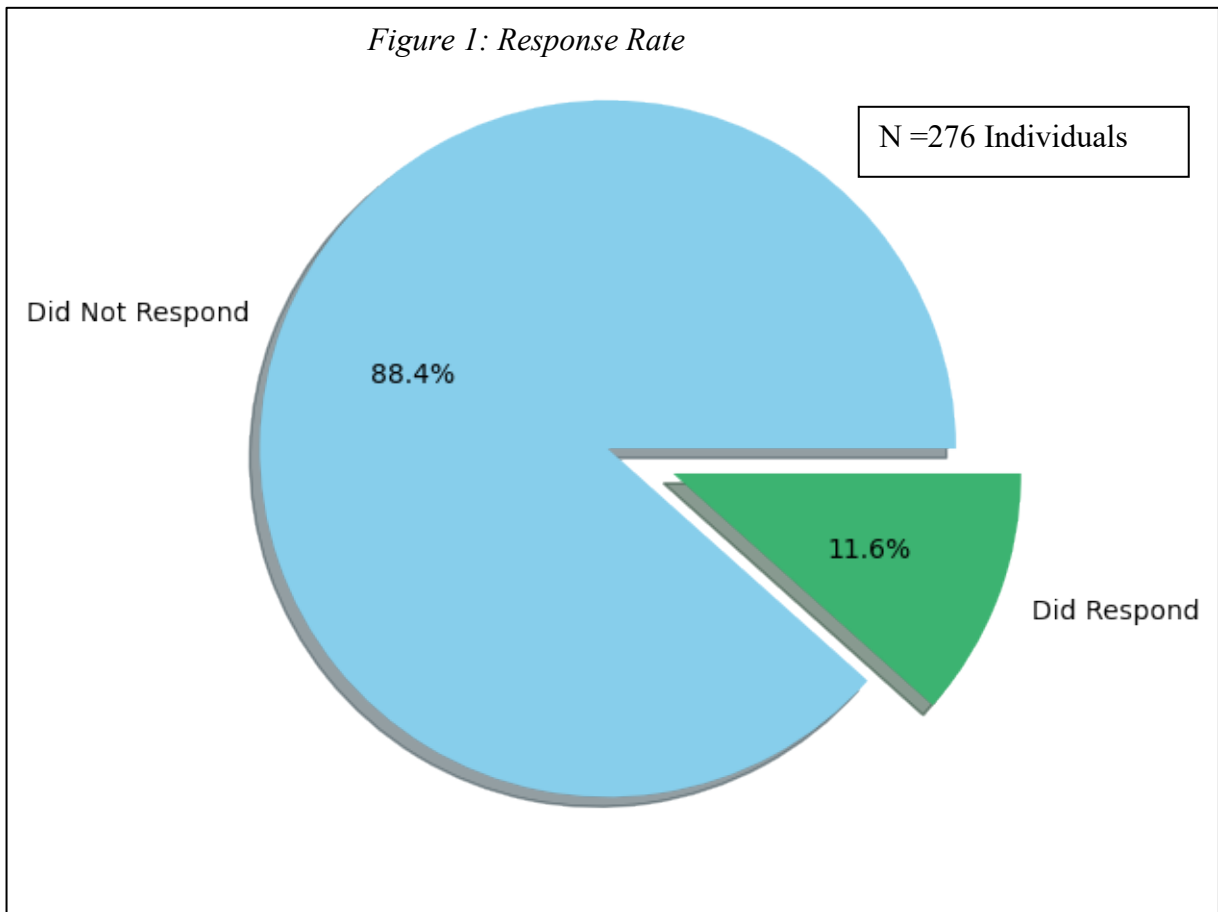

Response Rate

This survey was disseminated to 276 individuals who graduated with a Master’s Degree as members of the Class of 2021-2022. Out of these 276 graduates, 32 responded to the survey, giving the survey a Response Rate of **11.6 %**. Figure 1 (below) illustrates the Response Rate of this survey.
